She wrote Poems on Various Subjects, Religious and Moral, making her the first African American and first slave to publish a volume of poetry. Phillis Wheatley, First African-American Poet Phillis Wheatley (ca 1753 - December 5, 1784) was born in Senegal / Gambia, Africa. She was America's first African-American poet and one of the first women to be published in colonial America. She was also the first slave in the U.S. to have a book of poetry published. One of America's early literary giants, was an enslaved woman from Massachusetts, Phillis Wheatley.

Phillis Wheatley - americanliterature.com Phillis Wheatley (1753-1784) was the first African American female poet to be published. She was born in West Africa, sold into slavery and transported to Boston when she was 7 or 8, purchased by the Wheatley family, who taught her to read and encouraged her talent for writing. The people of Boston -- and of America and England -- bought books on other topics rather than the volume of Phillis Wheatley poems. Phillis Wheatley | National Women's History Museum Despite spending much of her life enslaved, Phillis Wheatley was the first African American and second woman (after Anne Bradstreet) to publish a book of poems. Born around 1753 in Gambia, Africa, Wheatley was captured by slave traders and brought to America in 1761.
